Subject: Involvement of Scouts and Guides in National Deworming Day, 10 February 2017

We thank you for the support extended by you and your team to make the Rajasthan Anganwadi and School based deworming program which is run under the aegis of National Deworming Day (NDD), a huge success in the year 2015 and 2016.

State is planning to implement upcoming round of National Deworming Day (NDD) on February 10, 2017, followed by a Mop-up day on February 15, 2017 in all the districts targeting children of 1-19 years for administration of Deworming Tablet (Albendazole) through Government Schools, Private Schools, Kendriya Vidhyalayas, Navodaya Vidhyalayas, Madarsa, Maa Badi Kendra and Anganwadi centers.

Also, kindly share the approximate number of scouts & guides to be involved by you across the state for National Deworming Day in February 2017.
